## Discharge Instructions for Bladder Instillation of Anti-cancer Drug

Follow-up appointment:	Please call 410-955-6100 to make sure all six or eight of your weekly appointments are scheduled.
What you might experience after your instillation:	Blood in your urine for 24-48 hours. Frequent and/or uncomfortable urination for 24-48 hours. These both can be helped by drinking 6-8 glasses of water or juice.
When to call your doctor:	Contact your doctor <i>immediately</i> if any of the following occurs: fever over 101 degrees (F) pain in the bladder area severe pain on urination foul smelling urine flu-like symptoms  Call 410-955-3801 during clinic hours (8am-5pm Monday –Friday). If after clinic hours, call 410-955-6070 and ask for the urology resident-on-call.
Activity:	Resume usual diet and activity. To prevent splashing, sit down on the commode when it is time to urinate out the medication. Wash hands and genital areas with soap and water or disposable personal wipes.
